McKinley attended the scene after the autopsy with Ident and it appears , based on where the cane was found, that Ms. Bartlett had made her way to the path that goes under the bridge, and walked along a paved foot path towards the Apt complex on KenCrest Ave. Ms Bartlett appears to have walked between the Apt and the Fenced compound. It's believed she slipped on the steep bank and lost her cane. She may have moved forward looking to recover same and slipped on the sharp rocks ending up at the fence. Ident advises they could make out impressions in the rock to support this. There is an opening under the fence that we believe she went through putting her in the compound. Not knowing where she was it is surmised that she came upon the concrete supports that slope up. Hearing the traffic above she may have believed it would take her up where she would have been seen by passing Motorists. It is believed she fell from the north side post.
